SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

Abstract Submission

- The abstract must be developed in Word Document Format, typed in Times New Roman in 12 font size with 1.5 line spacing in not more than 300 words. It should not contain more than eight Keywords.
- The abstract should contain personal details of the author(s) in the order: Title of the Paper, Author(s) Name, Designation, Institute/University/College/Organization, Contact Number, E-mail, and Address of Correspondence of the Author(s).
- Kindly indicate the name of the main author for correspondence, in case of more than one authors.
- Abstract Submission Link- https://forms.gle/nJbvMLpf8xFq5EDB9

Full Paper Submission

- The word limit of the paper shall be 3000-6000 words (exclusive of references).
- The main text of the full paper should be in Times New Roman with a font size of 12 and a line spacing of 1.5.
- One-inch margins should be maintained on all four sides of the pages.
- Full papers have to be submitted in Word.docx format.
- The submission of the full paper shall be carried out through the form link provided by us after the acceptance of the abstract.
- Registration is mandatory upon acceptance of the abstract, for presentation. The link to the registration form will be shared via email with the selected participants.
- Co-authorship is permitted to a maximum of three authors and at least one author must attend the Conference Online to present the paper.
- All submissions must be original and unpublished work of the author(s).
- More than 10% similarity will attract immediate disqualification for Plagiarism.
- A certificate has to be submitted for content created by Al. Only up to 10% is allowed.

Publication Opportunity

- Selected Papers will be recommended for publication in renowned SCOPUS/WOS/ABDC Indexed
 journals/Books including Peter Lang International Academic Publishers. Selected papers will also be
 published in Edited Books or Peer-reviewed journals by reputed National/International Publishers. The APC
 will be charged as per the Guidelines of respective journals.
- The selected authors will be required to follow the rules/guidelines of the respective journals/books for publication. All remaining approved papers will be published in an e-book with ISBN after due consent with the authors.

Participation Certificate

- E-Certificates will be emailed only to the registered participants.
- Co-authors are required to register by paying the registration fee separately to attend the Conference and receive the e-certificates.
- Presentation is mandatory for the participants (at least 1 author), to get the Certificate of participation.
