#### Round -1

- 2. Thereafter there will be discussions from both the sides for or against on the given topic.
- 3. Delegates can raise the placards to ask question after the speech of the concerned Delegate.
- 4. The decision of the coordinator of the session would be final.
- 5. The maximum limit of speech is 2 min for the first speech and 1 minute for the discussion.
- 6. The timing of the First round -9:30 12:00 on  $6^{\text{th}}$  September 2023.

#### Round -2

<u>Topic - Depoliticization of the global supply of food fertilizers and medical products so that</u> <u>geopolitical tensions do not lead to humanitarian crisis.</u>

Details of the Judging Criteria:

#### **Relevancy of Content:**

You will be marked on how much your content is inclusive of facts, figures and is relevant.

#### **Researching Skills:**

You will be marked on how extensively you have researched the topic and how well you are versed with the topic.

#### **Oratory Skills:**

This simply means your speaking skills, how well you deliver what you have researched.

#### **Code of Conduct:**

This includes whether you are disciplined, abiding by the rules and regulations and using formal language.

#### **Originality and Individuality:**

Participants ability to raise the points and convince the members, everything will be marked accordingly.

#### **Points to Remember:**

1. You will be judged on the basis of how practical and valid points you raise in Against/For of your topic.



- 2. You will be judged on the basis of your researching skills and how deeply you are through with the topic.
- 3. You will be judged on the basis of how you maintain decorum and discipline of the Conclave. Any activity which compromises on the discipline will be marked negatively.
- 4. You will be judged on the basis of how well spoken you are and how clearly you mention your points.
- 5. You will be marked on the basis of your individual performance.
