
Prof. (Dr.) V.K. Ahuja

CONCEPT NOTE

The Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code, 2016 was enacted on 28.05.2016, hails as a major economic measure with an objective to align the Indian insolvency law at par the international standards. The Code envisions a consolidated framework relating to reorganization and insolvency resolution of corporate persons, partnership firms and individuals in a timebound manner for the maximization of value of assets of such persons/entities and to promote entrepreneurship amongst others. The four pillars thus have been established for the fulfillment of the objective under the Code, which includes, Insolvency Professionals, Information Utilities, Adjudicating Authority, and the Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India.

Under the Code, the Indian insolvency regime has made great strides in providing a predictable framework that aims to provide timely, efficient and impartial resolution process of viable businesses and a transparent liquidation process.




