#### **ABOUT THE SPEAKER:**

Ms. Aishwarya Bhati, holding the position of Additional Solicitor General of India from the year of 2020 has the distinction of being the youngest woman lawyer & the only one from Rajasthan, to be conferred the designation of a Senior Advocate from Supreme Court of India in March 2019 and has represented the Union Government in a variety of cases, ranging from the constitutional validity of the Agnipath scheme to abortion rights. As a senior advocate, she played a key role in the case that led the Supreme Court to hold that Short Service Commissioned (SSC) women officers in the Indian Army were entitled to permanent commission.

In August 2022, she assisted the Supreme Court in a case where a 25-year-old unmarried woman sought to terminate her 24-week pregnancy, which was not allowed under the Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971. In September 2022, the Supreme Court widened the scope of the rules to allow unmarried women to terminate pregnancy.

Ms. Bhati noted that the amendments to India's Medical Termination of Pregnancy Act, 1971 were path breaking. *'The constitutional courts have ironed out small issues with the act and the rules in a seamless manner''*, she said.

She was Advocate-on-Record of the Supreme Court of India for 13 years prior to designation as a Senior Advocate. Being former Additional Advocate General for U.P. in Supreme Court from 2017 to 2020, she was the Counsel for the High Court of Delhi in Supreme Court. She was volunteer at Supreme Court Legal Services Committee (SCLSC), Supreme Court Middle Income Group Legal Aid Society (MIG) from the beginning of professional journey. She is also one of the youngest Additional Solicitor General of India, since June 2020 and the fourth woman in the country to occupy this coveted position.

Ms. Bhati has passionately fought for rights for women children and people with disabilities, sustainable environmental laws and also been a crusader advocate for anti-tobacco litigation.
