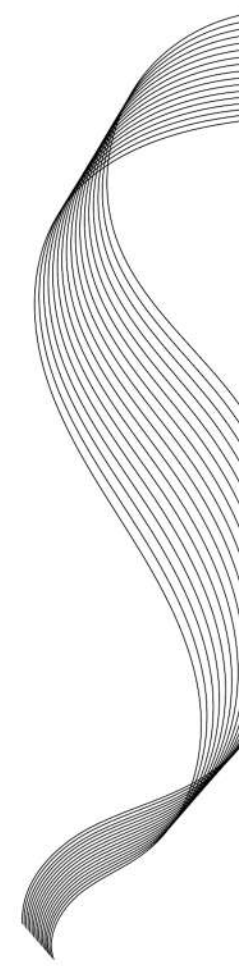
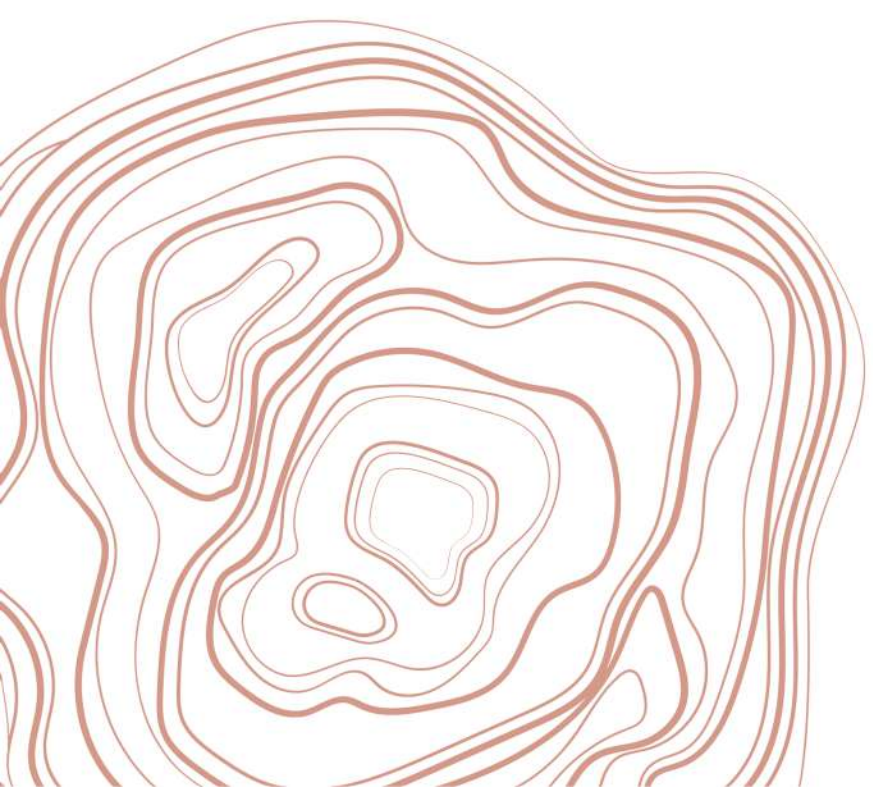


Guidelines for Abstract Submission

Abstract should abide by the following formatting rules:

1. Word Limit: 300–500 Words
2. Keywords: 5–7 Words
3. Abstract should be divided in a minimum of 3 paragraphs.
4. The abstract must be in an MS Word document, or a PDF format.
5. The Title shall be using Times New Roman font, size 14.
6. The abstract shall be written using Times New Roman font, size 12, line spacing 1.5, in *Italics*.

Guidelines for Chapter Submissions

The Chapter should abide by the following formatting rules:

1. Word Limit: 5000–8000 Words
2. Footnoting Style: Bluebook, 21st Edition.
3. The themes for the book are broadly suggestive. The Author may write on any topic relevant to the theme of the book.
4. Document formatting :
 - a. Times New Roman font, size 12, with 1.5 line spacing, justified text and 1-inch margins on all sides of an A4 sheet.
 - b. Footnotes should be in Times New Roman font, size 10, with 1.0 line spacing.
 - c. Endnotes and/or Bibliography and in-text citations are not allowed.
 - d. Headings should follow the following standard:
 - i. TITLE OF THE SUBMISSION: Upper-case, bold, font size 14
 - ii. HEADINGS: Upper-case, bold, font size 14
 - iii. Sub-Headings: Title-case, bold, font size 12
 - iv. Sub-Sub-Heading: Title-case, italics, font size 12
 - e. Submission must be the original work of the author and must not have been submitted elsewhere or pending review.
 - f. All the contributions should be the original work of the contributors. All submissions will undergo the plagiarism test.
 - g. Co-authorship up to a limit of two is allowed.
5. Authors are instructed to use footnotes only.
6. The manuscript should be accompanied by the author's name, designation, name of institute, contact number and e-mail for future reference and correspondence.
7. Once the abstract of concerned authors has been selected, they shall be intimated about the same along-with link and additional guidelines for paper submission.
