## **SUBMISSION GUIDELINES**

1. After payment of registration fee, the participants must register themselves by clicking on the following link: [Registration- 2nd UPES International Energy Law Judgment Writing Competition, 2017](#).
2. The Judgment must be written in English only.
3. For the format of judgment, participants may take help from the previous ICJ judgments available on the ICJ website - [www.icj-cij.org](http://www.icj-cij.org).
4. Participant must confine his/her judgment to the issues raised in the Moot Problem.
5. The Judgments must be submitted in .doc/.docx format only with 12pt font size and 1.5 line spacing in Times New Roman Font.
6. The Judgment should not be in more than 3000 words.
7. The author must not reveal his/ her identification in any part of the judgment.
8. The Judgment must be submitted by an Email addressed to [sollcolsupes@gmail.com](mailto:sollcolsupes@gmail.com) by May 15, 2017 (11:59 PM), with the subject line as- Judgment: 2<sup>nd</sup> UPES International Energy Law Judgment Writing Competition, 2017.
9. In the body of the email, the author must mention the following details:

  - Course Name
  - Name of the institution
  - Contact No.
  - Address
  - Email id
  - Registration fee submission details (attach a scanned copy of the Bank Receipt/ Transaction ID)
  - If there is a co-author, information regarding the co-author must be furnished in the format as mentioned above.
